NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause(s) of Section 2(1)(u) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023, the Government of Andhra Pradesh hereby declares with effect on and from the date of publication of this notification in the official gazette, the Place specified in column (1) of the Schedule below as Electronic Police Station (e-PS) for registration of Electronic Zero First Information Reports (e-Zero FIRs) reported through the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP) and National Cyber Crime Helpline (1930) in respect of notified categories of cyber financial frauds under section 173 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 for the areas specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof in respect of offences specified there under.

1. Designation:

The Cyber Crime Police Station, Crime Investigation Department, Andhra Pradesh, notified under references 1st and 2nd cited, is hereby in addition designated as Electronic Police Station (e-PS) registration of Electronic Zero First Information Reports (e-Zero FIRs) generated through the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP) and the National Cyber Crime Helpline (1930) in respect of such categories of cyber financial frauds as may be notified by the Government of India, the State Government or the Director General of Police from time to time.

2. Scope:

The designation under this Government Order is confined exclusively to the registration of Electronic Zero FIRs transmitted through the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP) and the National Cyber Crime Helpline (1930) ecosystem and their onward transmission to the jurisdictional Police Station.

Nothing contained in this Government Order shall be construed as creating a general electronic police station or as conferring jurisdiction upon the Cyber Crime Police Station, CID, Andhra Pradesh, to directly receive, entertain or register complaints from members of the public outside the mechanism specified herein.

3. Registration:

The Designated Police Station shall register an Electronic Zero FIR upon receipt of an electronically transmitted complaint from the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP) or the National Cyber Crime Helpline (1930), disclosing commission of a cognizable offence falling within the categories notified from time to time, irrespective of territorial jurisdiction, in accordance with the provisions of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

4. Transfer

Upon registration of an Electronic Zero FIR, the Designated Police Station shall electronically transfer the FIR together with the complaint details and available electronic records to the Police Station having territorial jurisdiction through CCTNS or any other Government-approved secure electronic platform for investigation in accordance with law.

5. Investigation

Upon receipt of the transferred Electronic Zero FIR, the jurisdictional Police Station shall assume responsibility for investigation and all consequential proceedings in accordance with the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, and other applicable laws.

6. Objective

The present GO is issued in continuation of and in addition to G.O. Ms. No. 128, dated 18.05.2002, and G.O. Ms. No. 116, dated 13.07.2017, to facilitate the implementation of the Government of India policy for the automatic conversion of Cyber Financial Crime complaints registered on the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP)/1930 Helpline into e-Zero FIRS to nab any criminal unprecedented speed.
